## **Highlanders get two wins**

On Friday, the McLennan Highlanders stomped the Schreiner Mountaineer JV 85-38.

The Mountaineers jumped out to an early 7-2 lead, but it was all Highlanders after that. MCC held Schreiner scoreless for just under 10 minutes down the stretch and held the advantage at the break 45-16.

The Highlanders continued to dominate in the second half as they cruised to the easy victory.

Freshman Taylor Smith led the Highlanders with 20 points, and Karlos Gary added 14. T. J. Johnson and Trell Porter scored 12 and 10, respectively.

Saturday's game provided a bigger test for the Highlanders, but they were able to remain undefeated as they topped the Angelina Roadrunners 73-61. The Highlanders controlled the game in the first half, leading by as many as 22 as they held the Roadrunners to just two points in the first 10 minutes of the game. Angelina picked up their game down the stretch and cut MCC's lead to 14 at the break, 37-23.

The Roadrunners continued to chip away at the Highlander lead in the second half, cutting it to five with 12:41 remaining in the game. But the Highlanders rallied back, increasing the lead to double digits with just over six minutes to go.

Angelina cut the lead to nine twice in the final two and a half minutes, but the Highlanders were able to hold off the Roadrunner charge by going 12-16 from the free-throw line.

Sophomore Nafis Richardson led the Highlanders with 19 points, and Tre Nichols added 15.

The Highlanders return to action today, traveling to face Richland at 7 p.m.
