

Health & Human Services Course Schedule

NOTICE: Prior to entering the Nurse Aide, Medication Administration for Nurse Aide, or Massage Therapy programs, students will be required to show proof of immunization against Hepatitis B, measles, mumps, rubella, and diphtheria/tetanus, and a tuberculosis skin test or chest x-ray. In addition to the immunization requirements, students must obtain and present the results of a drug screen and Texas statewide criminal background check. Nurse Aide Training Day Course

Certified Nurse Aide: Your First Step in a Health Career MCC is an approved provider of the federally required course for anyone wishing to work as a certified nurse aide (CNA) in a long-term care facility. The course provides information and training in basic nursing techniques. For the clinical portion of this course, students must have a dark green scrub suit, a watch with a second hand, and white shoes. State certification testing is scheduled as soon as possible after completion of class. Students will be responsible for paying the cost of the state testing (\$83).

Medication Administration for Nurse Aide

This course is designed to increase the accuracy and safety of drug administration to nursing home residents. Following successful completion of the program and required state testing, graduates will be listed on a central roster with the Texas Department of Health. Strict

admission criteria apply. In addition to immunization requirements, drug screen and criminal background check, the following prerequisites must be completed and presented at registration: (1) **notarized** high school diploma or GED, (2) Current CNA credentials, 3) a permission letter on organizational letterhead paper from a nursing home to perform clinical observation at their site.

CMA Recertification

This course fulfills the state certification board requirements for recertification of CMAs. The course is required once yearly for all medication aides, before their CMA license expires. Meets last Thursday of each month, unless otherwise noted. **Due to state regulations, absolutely no admission to the classroom after 8:00 a.m. Bring pen/pencil, paper, current CMA license, and state-issued picture ID to class.**

Massage Therapy (Day or Evening Program Available)

The massage therapy program covers the following: anatomy, physiology, health and hygiene, hydrotherapy, kinesiology, pathology, massage therapy techniques, business practices, and professional ethics. At the end of 450 hours of didactic instruction, there is a 50-hour internship. During the internship students will give hour-long massages to members of our community. NOTE: The times for the last 50 hours of class will be adjusted to fit internship requirements.
