

NURSING: RN

- * A grade-point average of at least 2.0 in the full nursing curriculum and a grade average of C or better in all courses will qualify the student to receive the Associate in Applied Science Degree and to make application to write the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses.
- ** Completion of Level I curriculum will qualify the student to receive a Certificate of Completion as a Nursing Assistant.
- *** Completion of all Level I and Level II required nursing courses with a cumulative grade average of C or better will qualify the student to enter Level III.
- **** Completion of RNSG 1523, RNSG 1462, RNSG 2504 and RNSG 1463 with a grade of "C" or better will qualify the student to enter RNSG 1293 and RNSG 1160. Completion of RNSG 1292 and RNSG 1160 with a grade of "C" or better will qualify the student to enter VNSG 1463. VNSG 1463 and VNSG 1119 are optional courses to meet licensure requirements for Board of Vocational Nursing. See course description in General Catalogue
- ***** Prerequisite for Level III: Completion of all Level I & II required courses with a grade point average of at least 2.0 and a cumulative grade average of C or better in all Level I & II nursing courses. Students may also enroll in RNSG 2514 and RNSG 2462 if they successfully complete the challenge examinations or RNSG 1327, Transition FROM Vocational to Professional Nursing. See the section entitled Advanced Standing for Licensed Vocational Nurses in the General College Catalogue for details regarding those two paths for entry into RNSG 2514. Enrollment in RNSG 2462 is limited.
