- *** Completion of all Level I and Level II required nursing courses with a cumulative grade average of C or better will qualify the student to enter Level III.
- **** Completion of RNSG 1523, RNSG 1462, RNSG 2504 and RNSG 1463 with a grade of "C" or better will qualify the student to enter RNSG 1293 and RNSG 1161. Completion of RNSG 1293 and RNSG 1161 with a grade of "C" or better will qualify the student to enter VNSG 1463. VNSG 1463, VNSG 1119 and RNSG 1162 are optional courses to meet licensure requirements for Board of Vocational Nursing. See course description in General Catalogue
- ***** Prerequisite for Level III: Completion of all Level I & II required courses with a grade point average of at least 2.0 and a cumulative grade average of C or better in all Level I & II nursing courses. Students may also enroll in RNSG 2514 and RNSG 2462 if they successfully complete the challenge examinations or RNSG 1327, Transition FROM Vocational to Professional Nursing.
