

# Selection Criteria for Veterinary Technology Program Applicants

## TOTAL POSSIBLE POINTS- 390 points

Health Occupations Aptitude Exam= 380 points Max

College GPA= 5 points Max

Residency= 5 points Max

**Health Occupations Aptitude Exam-** This is the largest portion of all of the available points. There are 380 possible points to be earned on this exam. You need a minimum score of 210 to be considered for admission into the MCC Veterinary Technology Program. If you take this exam multiple times, only the highest score is considered.

### College Grade Point Average-

3.75 or above.....	5 points
3.5 – 3.74.....	4 points
3.0 – 3.49.....	3 points
2.75 – 2.9.....	2 points
2.5 – 2.74.....	1 point
Below 2.49.....	0 points

### Residency-

**McLennan County Residents.....5 points**

Outside McLennan County, but within surrounding HOTCOG Service Area....2 points

**All applicants must be Texas State Initiative (TSI) complete prior to entering into the MCC Veterinary Technology Program.** Your TSI status is determined by taking either the THEA or Accuplacer exam at the MCC Testing Center (254) 299-8453. If it is determined that developmental courses are needed, those courses must be completed prior to entering the MCC Veterinary Technology Program. If you have questions regarding your TSI status, contact the MCC Admissions Office at (254) 299-8628

**Volunteer Hours-** All applicants must finish their 50 hours of working for/volunteer with/observation of a veterinary office prior to the June 15<sup>th</sup> application deadline. Exceptions to this rule can be made with the permission of the Program Director (254) 299-8750.

**Prerequisites-** The following college prerequisites must be completed with a grade of “C” or better prior to entry into the MCC Veterinary Technology Program:

ENGL 1301 Freshman Composition I.....3 Hours

MATH 1332 Contemporary Liberal Arts Math.....3 Hours

BIOL 1413 Introductory Zoology.....4 Hours

PSYC 2301 General Psychology.....3 Hours
