

E. Animal Care Aide, Cameron Park Zoo

Organization Description: Cameron Park Zoo describes its mission as wildlife conservation and research, educating others about nature, and preserving biological diversity.

Volunteer Duties: Volunteers can help with diet preparation, maintaining animal habitats, and organizing enrichment items for the animals.

Volunteer Requirements: Volunteers must be 18 years or older. They must complete an application, attend an orientation, pass a background check, and have a tuberculosis test.

Training Provided: All training is provided, no prior experience is necessary.

Time Commitment: Volunteers must commit to 48 hours a year.

Recommended For: Students in the fields of education and others.

Benefits: Volunteers gain hands-on experience in education and conservation, while learning more about a variety of animals, their care, and their behavior. Volunteers also receive a 10% discount at the Zoo CafT and Zootique, see new exhibits before the public, and get to attend an annual appreciation dinner.
