Date: January 31, 2001

Students who achieve and maintain prescribed standards of scholarship shall be awarded special recognition by inclusion on the Dean's List at the end of each semester and by inclusion as an honor graduate at the annual Commencement Exercises. The Dean of Student Services shall be responsible for the preparation of the Dean's List at the end of the fall and spring semesters. In any semester, to be recognized for the Dean's List, a student must complete twelve or more college level semester hours and earn a grade point average of 3.5 or higher.

To receive special recognition as an honor graduate at the Commencement Exercises, a student must have completed 60 or more college level semester hours with a cumulative grade point average of 3.50 or better. Special recognition categories and the grade averages required for each are as follows:

4.00	Highest Honors
3.80 - 3.99	High Honors
3.50 - 3.79	Honors

Students who graduate with highest honors shall be presented a special award during the Commencement Exercises.
