4 - The total Occupational Specialization credit hours MUST equate to a minimum of 12 semester credit hour equivalents in order to be eligible for the BAAS degree and a maximum of 33 hours. All 33 credit hours may come from technical training (non-transferable coursework, continuing education, military schools, work experience etc.). All training must be approved by the BAAS Committee for credit. Credit must be related to the subject matter taught in Child and Family Studies, and must be documented (transcripts, certificate of completion, employer training records, etc.).

Each prospective BAAS student is evaluated individually to determine eligibility for the degree program. Various community college child development-related courses may be used as part of the Occupational Specialization. Please see the Tarleton State University College of Education-CHFS BAAS advisor for more information.

5 - Electives: 0-21 hours depending on the number of Prior Learning Credits applied. The total credits combined for coursework, training and/or electives must total 36 SCH. Students must qualify with a minimum of 12 SCH equivalents of technical/vocational and/or training to pursue this degree program.
