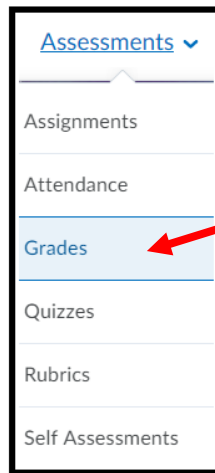


How to See Feedback on Graded Assignments
