

Guidance for Unvaccinated Individuals

Employees, students, or visitors at McLennan Community College (MCC) who are not fully vaccinated for COVID-19 should continue to follow these recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and MCC.

- Continue to wear a facemask indoors when in common areas. This includes classrooms, lobbies, lounges, dining halls (except when eating), hallways, elevators, and common area bathrooms when in close proximity to others.
- Continue to wear a facemask outside when physical distancing is not possible and when around people who don't live in their household.
- Continue to follow physical distancing recommendations both indoors and outdoors.
- If you feel sick you should self-report and be tested for COVID-19. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, you should stay home for at least 10-days since symptoms first appeared and at least 24 hours fever free without fever-reducing medication and symptoms have improved. Do not leave your home, except to get medical care. Do not visit public areas including the MCC campus.
- If you are in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, you should self-report and stay home for at least 10 days after exposure. Do not leave your home. Do not visit public areas including the MCC campus. If you develop symptoms you should be tested and continue to self-quarantine until you receive the results.
