Part A—Reduced Tuition

McLennan Community College will provide reduced tuition for all high school students attending public, private, or home schools, who:

- 1. are enrolled in dual credit, early college high school, and/or early admission classes, and
- 2. reside in McLennan or Falls County (McLennan Community College service area) or are enrolled at a McLennan County high school.

NOTE: Out-of-county students who are not enrolled at a McLennan County high school will be eligible for the reduced tuition rate only if they attend classes face to face on the McLennan Community College campus or at a McLennan County High School.

Part B—Exemption

If students qualify for reduced tuition and show documented financial need as determined by McLennan Community College, the College will exempt students from the payment of tuition and fees.

In addition, MCC will encourage all school districts enrolling students in dual credit courses to provide these students with funding for the appropriate textbooks and/or instructional materials.
