

Alcohol and Other Drugs on McLennan campus

MCC is a drug-free campus as described by the Federal Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendment of 1989. It is a violation of the “General Conduct Policy” to possess, attempt to possess, use, transmit, or distribute (sell) drugs or alcohol* on the campus or at any building, facility, grounds, or other property owned, leased, or controlled by the institution ([Highlander Guide](#), see page 18).

Any student found responsible for violating MCC's drug and alcohol policies as defined in the “General Conduct Code” may receive sanctions, conditions and restrictions, such as (but not limited to) disciplinary probation, deferred suspension, suspension, and other educational outcomes.
