



Judge Ken Starr Memorial Lecturer **DR. OS GUINNESS**

The old oak trees on McLennan Community College campus stand tall. Despite gnarled branches, the leaves dance and sing in the breeze. Some trees bear weathered bark while other showcase mossy trunks. They add a timeless charm to the academic landscape, and the sprawling canopies provide both shade and a sense of venerable wisdom.

The beauty of our campus drew Alice and Judge Ken Starr in. The pair regularly strolled through the dappled light across campus. Judge Starr loved the fountain, where he and Mrs. Starr would sit and enjoy coffee, conversation, and the laughter that accompanies them both. But more than the beauty of campus, Judge Starr was drawn to MCC because of his unwavering belief in the next generation.

Before his passing, Judge Starr funded the Alice Starr Plaza which aptly sits in the heart of campus. After his passing in September of 2022, MCC President, Dr. Johnette McKown, commemorated a bench in honor of Judge Starr. The bench sits under the shade of a sprawling oak, near the fountain, and with an unobstructed view of the Alice Starr Plaza.

The bench remains as a daily and lasting reminder of the work, life, and passion of Judge Starr, but Highlanders were treated to a very special memorial this year. On September 13, 2023—the one year anniversary of Judge Starr’s passing—the college hosted a special guest speaker for our Ken Starr Memorial Lecture. Dr. Os Guinness, a celebrated author, philosopher, and social critic, spent the day on campus, honoring the memory of his personal friend.

In the morning, Dr. Guinness spoke to students who packed the lecture hall. His topic came from *The Quest*, one of his 30+ published works, and focused on

helping young people think critically about who they want to be in the world. He attended a dedication for the Judge Ken Starr bench with Dr. McKown and Mrs. Starr, alongside the Starr family and many students. In the evening, Dr. Guinness gave a rousing presentation to hundreds of community members.

Dr. Guinness, like Judge Starr, stands out among leaders.



The two men had witnessed much and learned even more from their experiences, and both were equally excited about passing their wisdom along to the next generation. Dr. Guinness, a graduate of Oxford, praised the beauty of McLennan Community College lavishly, but went on to say that he was even more impressed with the students, faculty, and staff. "I have heard that MCC is like the Oxford of community colleges," said Dr. Guinness, "but I actually think it is better than Oxford. Because I can see how much people care about the students—about their success. And you don't get that at Oxford."

McLennan Community College is grateful for friends like Alice and Judge Ken Starr. We were honored to memorialize this man and his impressive life of service to others. And we are privileged to have played host to Dr. Guinness. These individuals, and many more, leave indelible impressions upon future generations. For what more than that could we ask?
