Vocational Nursing majors have three program academic years to complete the curriculum after official enrollment in the first program course. If the student withdraws from a program course and then re-enters the program, the student must still complete within the time allotted.

Failure in any program course indicates the possibility of failure on the licensing examination. Therefore, no more than one program course may be repeated and that course may be repeated only once during the three academic year time period. Students who withdraw from a program course must still complete the curriculum within the allowed three-year period. If, for any reason, the student is unable to complete the program within the allowed three-year period, he/she may apply to compete as a new applicant. In such an instance, the applicant would start at the beginning of the program academic year.

A program course has the prefix of the major, i.e.: **VNSG** courses are program courses for the Vocational Nursing Program.
