Organization Description: Mission Waco offers a variety of programs, and describes its mission as:

Volunteer Duties: Volunteers assist the Director in fulfilling planned program, as well as engage in mentoring, tutoring, and relationship building.

Volunteer Requirements: Volunteers must complete a volunteer application and liability form, supply one reference, be approved by the organization, pass a background check (\$5 fee), and comply with other requirements specific to the program.

Training Provided: Training varies according to the type of commitment desired. Volunteers who will work directly with participants must attend an orientation.

Time Commitment: Preferably weekly/on a regular basis. School semester schedule is Monday-Thursday, 3:00 pm to 5:30 pm. Summer schedule is morning hours, Monday - Thursday, time TBD.
