

P. Driver Meals and Wheels, Meals on Wheels

Organization Description: Meals & Wheels delivers meals and other services to clients who are unable to provide meals and other services for themselves.

Volunteer Duties: Volunteer duties consist of delivering meals and chatting with clients.

Volunteer Requirements: Volunteers must complete an application and pass a background check. For some Meals & Wheels programs you may need a valid driver's license as well as car insurance.

Training Provided: Necessary training is provided onsite.

Time Commitment: A variety of time commitments are available to fit into your schedule, such as an hour a week for meal deliveries, or several hours a month as a substitute meal deliverer.

Group Volunteering: There are a number of opportunities for groups, including doing deep cleaning of clients' homes, helping with special mailings to raise money, and emergency meal packaging.

Recommended For: Students in the fields of nursing, education, human services, and others.

Benefits: Volunteers can make connections with others in the Waco community, and form long lasting relationships.
