Organization Description: Mission Waco offers a variety of programs, and describes its mission as:

- 1. Provide Christian-based and relationship- based programs that empower the poor and marginalized
- 2. Mobilize middle-class Americans to become more compassionately involved among the poor
- 3. Seek ways to overcome the systemic issues of social injustice which oppress the poor and marginalized

Volunteer Duties: Pre-med, Pre-nursing, and professional volunteers assist in medical or dental consults.

Volunteer Requirements: Volunteers must complete a volunteer application and liability form, supply one reference, be approved by the organization, pass a background check (\$5 fee), and comply with other requirements specific to the program.

Training Provided: Training varies according to the type of commitment desired. Volunteers who will work directly with participants must attend an orientation.

Time Commitment: Licensed professionals on monthly rotating schedule, preferably twice a month. College volunteers also assigned to a rotating schedule; usually 2-3 shifts per month.
