L. House Construction, Habitat for Humanity

Organization Description: Waco Habitat for Humanity describes itself as a non-denominational Christian housing ministry, which works in partnership with low-income families to eliminate substandard and poverty housing in Waco, TX.

Volunteer Duties: Volunteers work in partnership with local families in need of decent shelter by helping to build a house.

Volunteer Requirements: Volunteers working on a building site must sign a waiver, and be 18 or over, or 16 to 17 with an adult. They must wear close-toed shoes and dress according to the weather.

Training Provided: Volunteers will receive instruction on the day's tasks, and will not be expected to do anything he or she is uncomfortable doing.

Time Commitment: Volunteers may sign up for a morning (8:30-12:00) or afternoon (1:00-4:30) construction shift. Volunteers may work as few as one shift, or as many as they like.

Group Volunteering: It is okay for volunteers to come as a group of 10 or fewer people.

Recommended For: Students in the fields of Social Work and many more.

Benefits: Volunteers benefit by having fun doing community service, helping to preserve the environment, learning or teaching others about construction, meeting new and interesting people, and making a difference.
