Group Volunteering: Group volunteers are welcome! Single days of service include helping with adoption events, painting projects and general shelter cleaning.

Recommended For: Education, business and medical students can apply for internships to help toward their major.

Benefits: Volunteers benefit by learning more about animals, animal behavior and will work directly with staff and customers to help save lives of shelter animals.
