Organization Description: The Lake Waco Wetlands were constructed as a habitat mitigation project that began as a result of raising the level of Lake Waco by seven feet. The wetland functions to provide habitat for native species, to help "clean" water, and to provide educational programs and science based activities for visitors.

Requirements: Wear appropriate outdoor clothing, such as closed toed shoes, and be prepared to bring sunscreen and other items.

Training Provided: All necessary training will be provided on site.

Time Commitment: Any time commitment is welcomed, but must schedule a volunteer time first.

Group Volunteering: Groups are welcome, but must schedule a volunteer time first.

Recommended For: Students in the fields of biology, ecology, and more.

Benefits: Students gain hands on experiences in the biological and environmental sciences in a wetland environment while enjoying the outdoors.
