### A parent account through the High School Pathways Portal permits you to:

- Grant consent for the high school student to enroll at MCC.
  If the student grants you access to his/her financial and academic records:
- Review the student's MCC schedule.
- Review the end-of-semester MCC grades (on the unofficial transcript).
- ✤ Make a tuition payment.

# Giving Parental Consent

- You only need to give consent to enroll once during the student's time in high school.
- If giving consent online is not possible, you may request a paper consent form from the High School Pathways office.

# 1. You will receive an email from dualcredit@mclennan.edu.

- Please watch your spam/junk folder for the email.
- In the student portion of the portal, your son or daughter will select the Provide Parent Info button on the Progress Tracker and then enter your first name, last name, email address, and potentially grant you access to academic and/or financial records. This triggers the parent email.

**NOTE:** If you do not receive the email, please ask the student to return to the portal and select the Provide Parent Info button again to send another email.

# 2. Use the link in the email to go to the High School Pathways Portal.

• If you prefer not to use the link, you may type https://gateway.mclennan.edu into your browser.

# 3. Create an account and/or log in.

- Follow the steps on the screen to create an account and log in.
- Save your username and password for future use.

- ✤ If you did not use the link in the email, select "add child." Enter the activation code from the email to add your son/daughter.
