All research grants will be awarded based on both the merit of the primary investigator and the merit of the project. Grants are only available for research projects related to courses in which the student is (or will be in the upcoming semester) actively enrolled.

Submit your completed application, along with necessary documentation, to huri@mclennan.edu. There is a “rolling deadline” whereby applications will be evaluated as they come in, usually twice a month. Award decisions will be made as a committee and all available funds may be disbursed before the end of the semester. Early applications may find more success.
