ELIGIBILITY & CATEGORIES

High School (HS)

Open to High School sophomores through seniors level. Cannot be younger than 15 years old on April 2, 2020. Cannot be older than 20 years old on April 2, 2020. No limit on length of study.

Lower College (LC)

Open to freshmen and sophomores. Cannot be younger than 18 years old on April 2, 2020. Cannot be older than 23 years old on April 2, 2020. No limit on length of study.



Competitors must be students currently attending high schools, colleges or universities in the State of Texas. Home-schooled high school students are also eligible.



MUSICAL THEATER REPERTOIRE BOTH CATEGORIES

- One ballad
- One song from a time period of your choice



AUDITION TIME LIMITS ALL CATEGORIES

- High School (8 mins)
- Lower College (10 mins)

REPERTOIRE CHANGES

Are allowed, but must be made by April 17, 2020 if using competition pianists. The contestant will announce repertoire changes from the stage at the contest.



CLASSICAL REPERTOIRE BOTH CATEGORIES

- One art song or aria in Italian, Spanish, French, OR German
- One art song or aria in English
- Repertoire must include ONE aria and ONE art song.
- At least TWO different languages must be represented.
