Executive Summary

Enrollment Profiles prior to Fall 2022 used a different data source than the Enrollment Profile of Fall 2022 file onward. Due to this, the results may be different between previous files and Fall 2022 onward files.

Enrollment Profiles of Fall 2022 file onward contains only students enrolled as of the census date of the term, and excludes any students enrolled in 2nd-8week courses only.

Fall 2023

The undergraduate enrollment of 7,368 included 1,132 first-time in college students, 379 new transfer students, 1,967 dual credit students, 3,049 continuing students, and 841 returning students. Eighty-one percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-seven percent of students are female, and fifty-seven percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Thirty-eight percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 22.7 years on the census date of the fall term.

Eighty-four percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four-year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), thirty-one percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 8.2.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (38.9%), General Studies (22.6%), Registered Nurse (6.7%), Business Administration and Management (4.3%), and Liberal Arts and Sciences, General Studies and Humanities, Other (2.7%).

Fall 2022

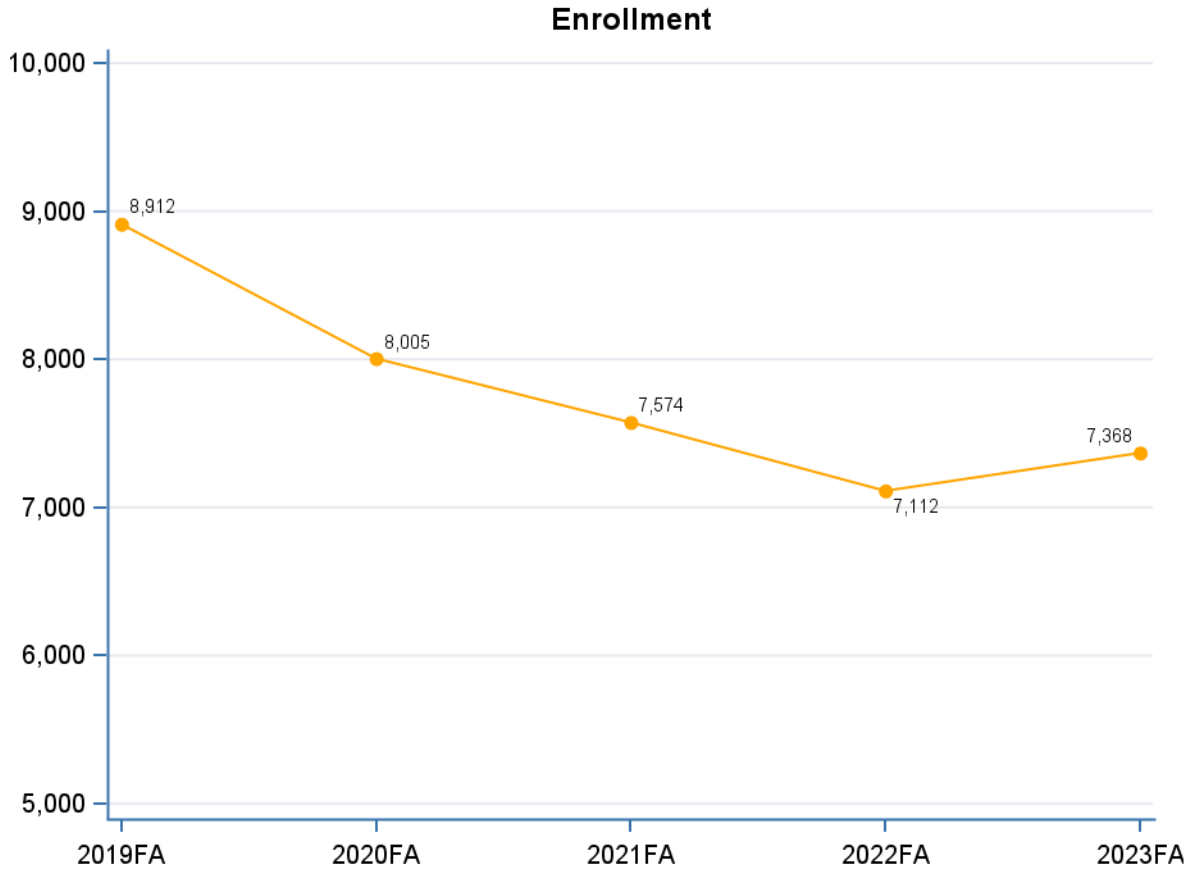
The undergraduate enrollment of 7,112 included 1,078 first-time in college students, 382 new transfer students, 1,773 dual credit students, 3,064 continuing students, and 815 returning students. Eighty percent are from McLennan County. Sixty-eight percent of students are female, and fifty-five percent are members of racial or ethnic minority groups. Thirty-eight percent of students are in the age range of 18-21 with an overall average age of 23.1 years on the census date of the fall term.

Eighty-one percent of students are enrolled in academic majors designed to transfer to a four-year school. Using the state definition of full-time (which excludes flex classes), thirty-two percent are full-time students. The overall average credit hour load excluding flex classes is 8.4.

The top 5 areas of study (by CIP Code) are Liberal Arts & Sciences (38.9%), General Studies (22.6%), Registered Nurse (6.7%), Business Administration and Management (4.3%), and Liberal Arts and Sciences, General Studies and Humanities, Other (2.7%).

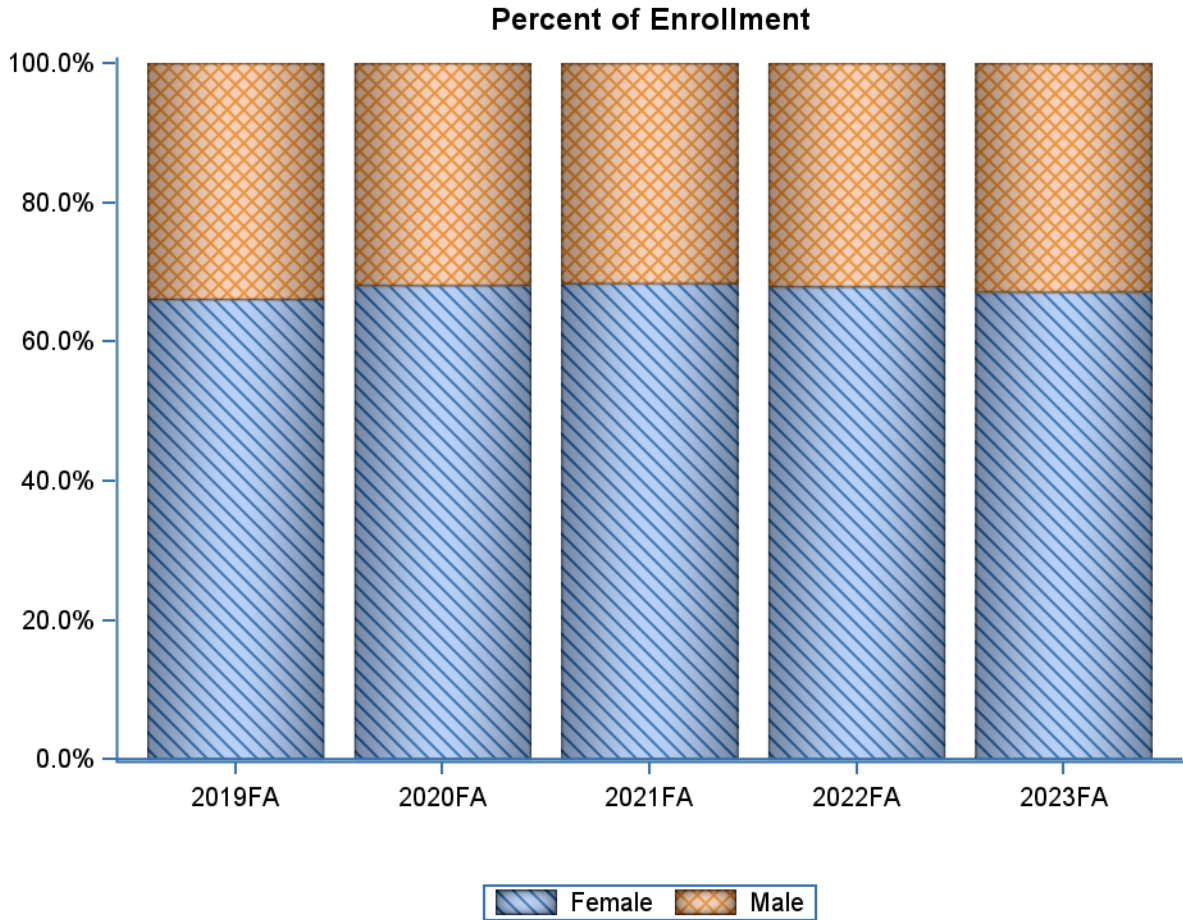

Profile of all Students, Fall 2019 to Fall 2023 Gender

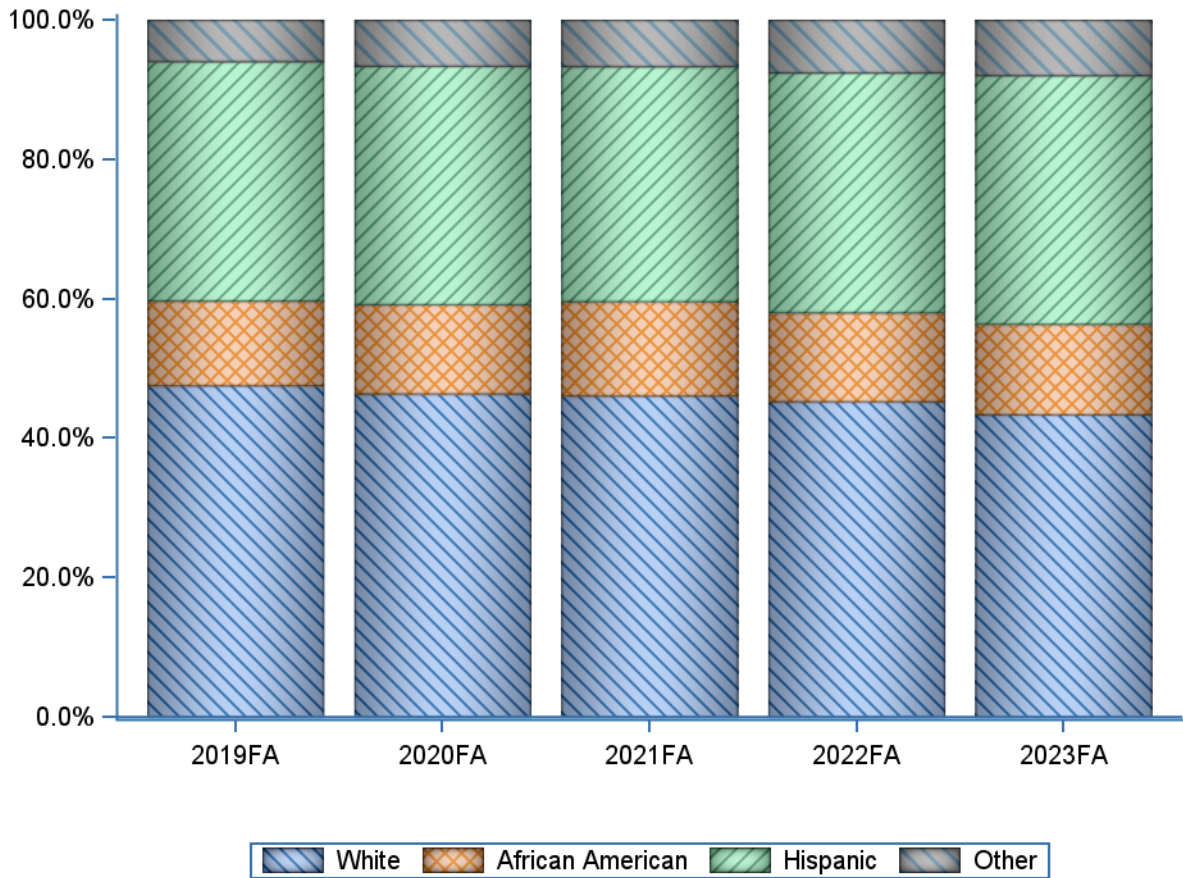

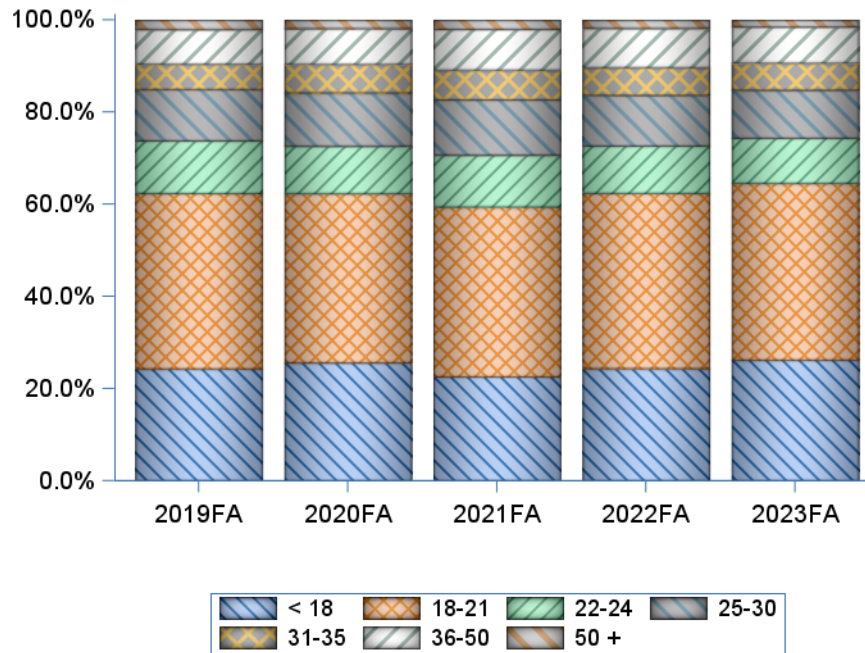
Percent of Enrollment



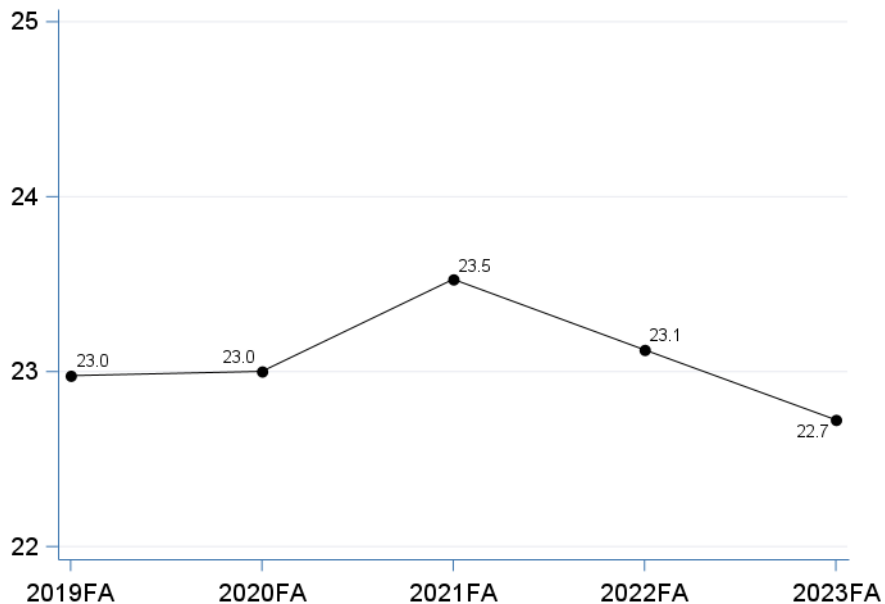

Percent of Enrollment

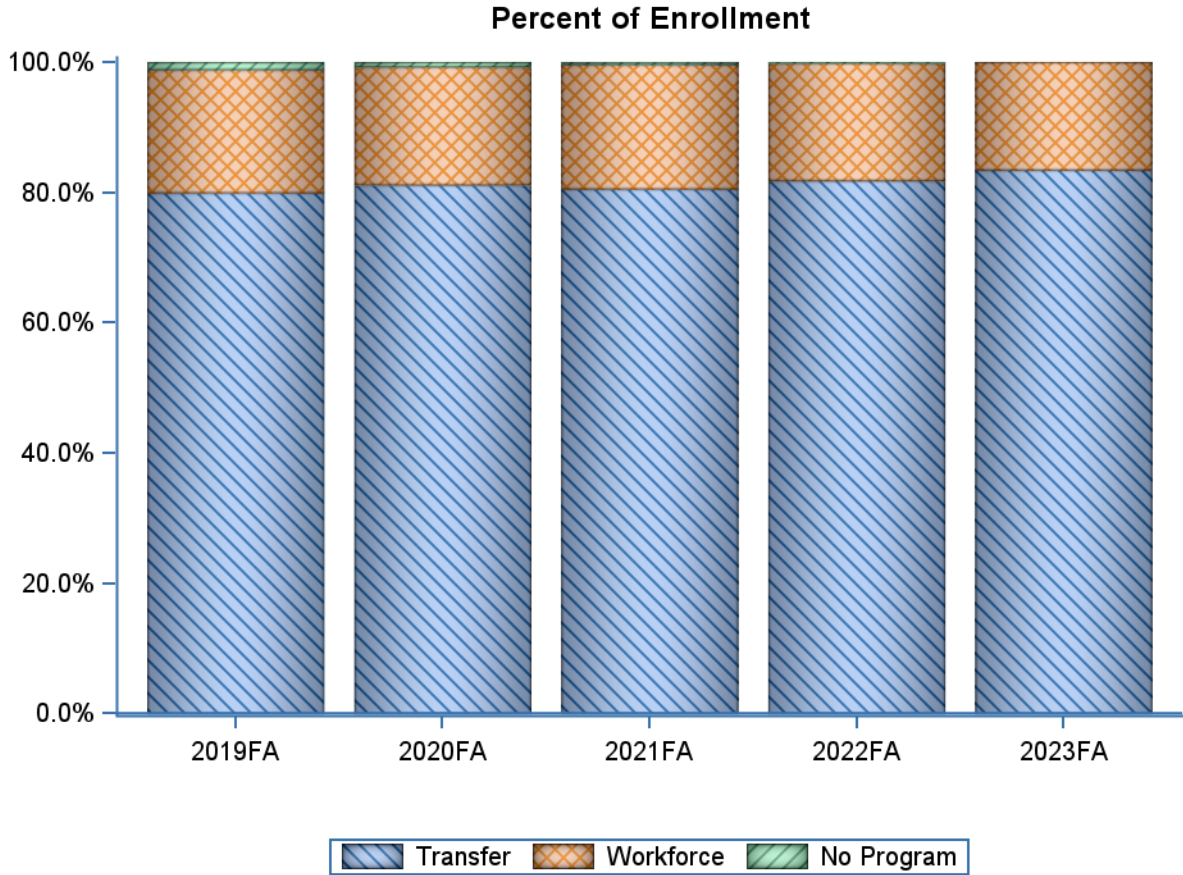


Average Age

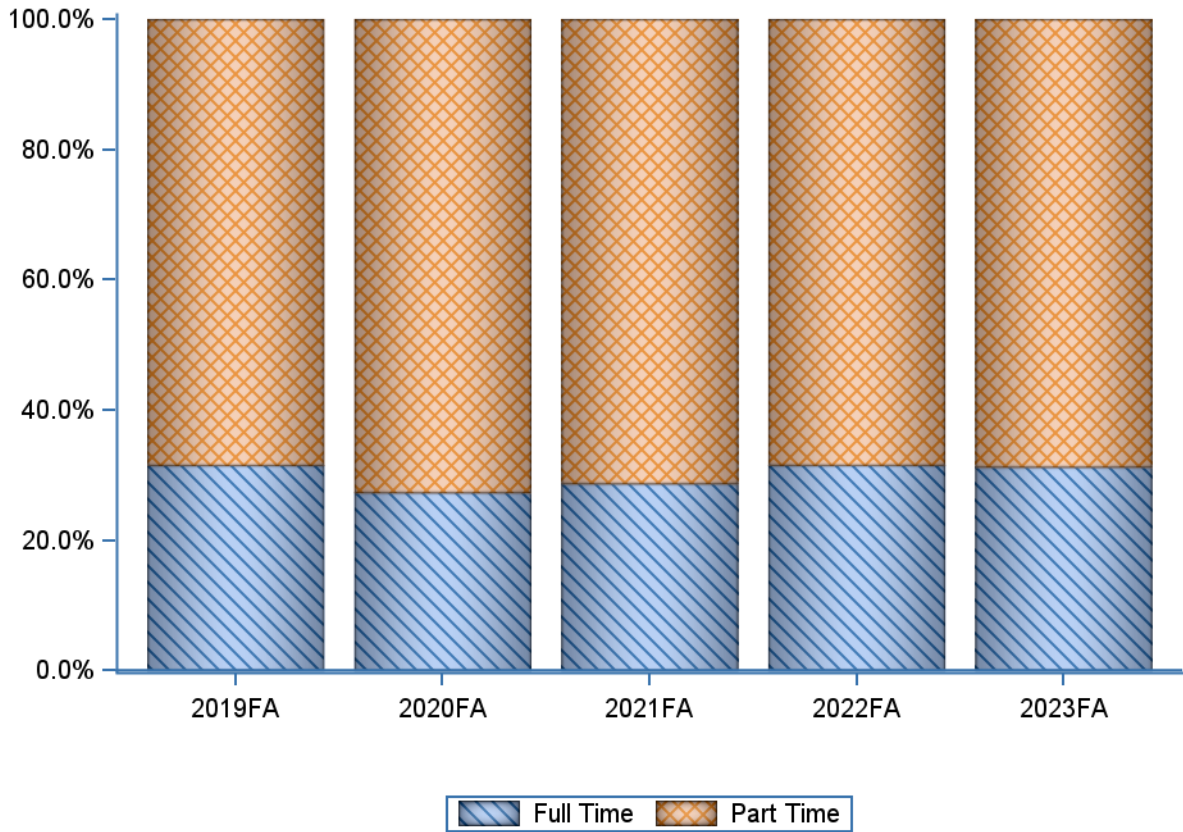

Percent of Enrollment

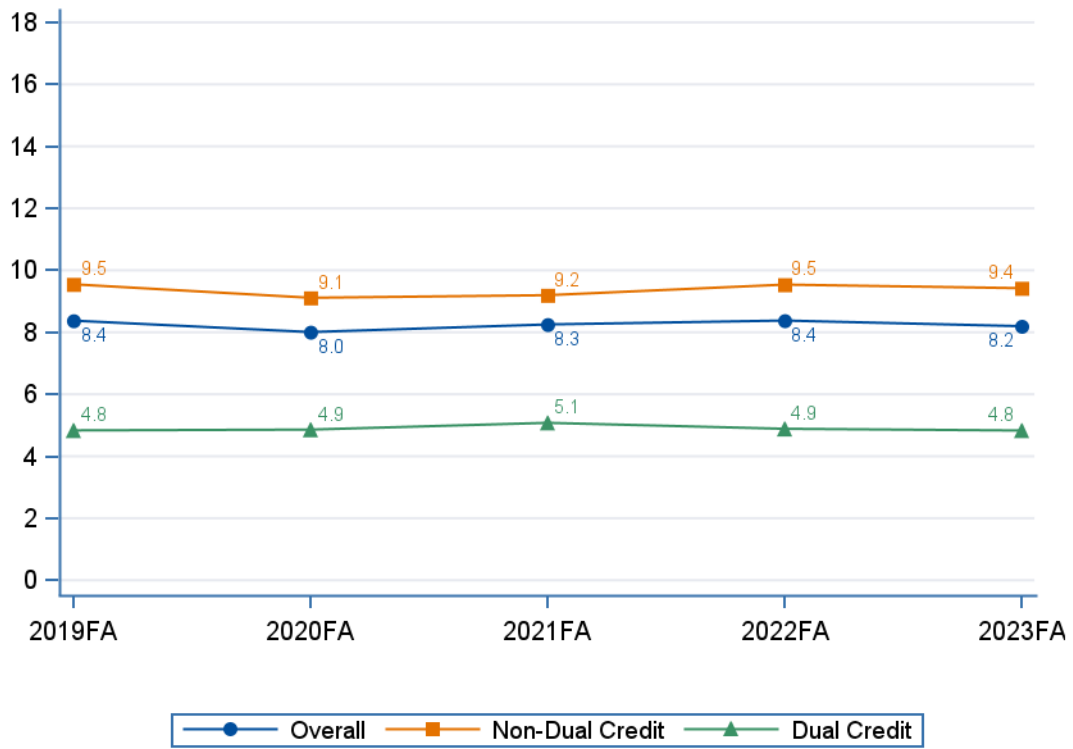

Average Hours

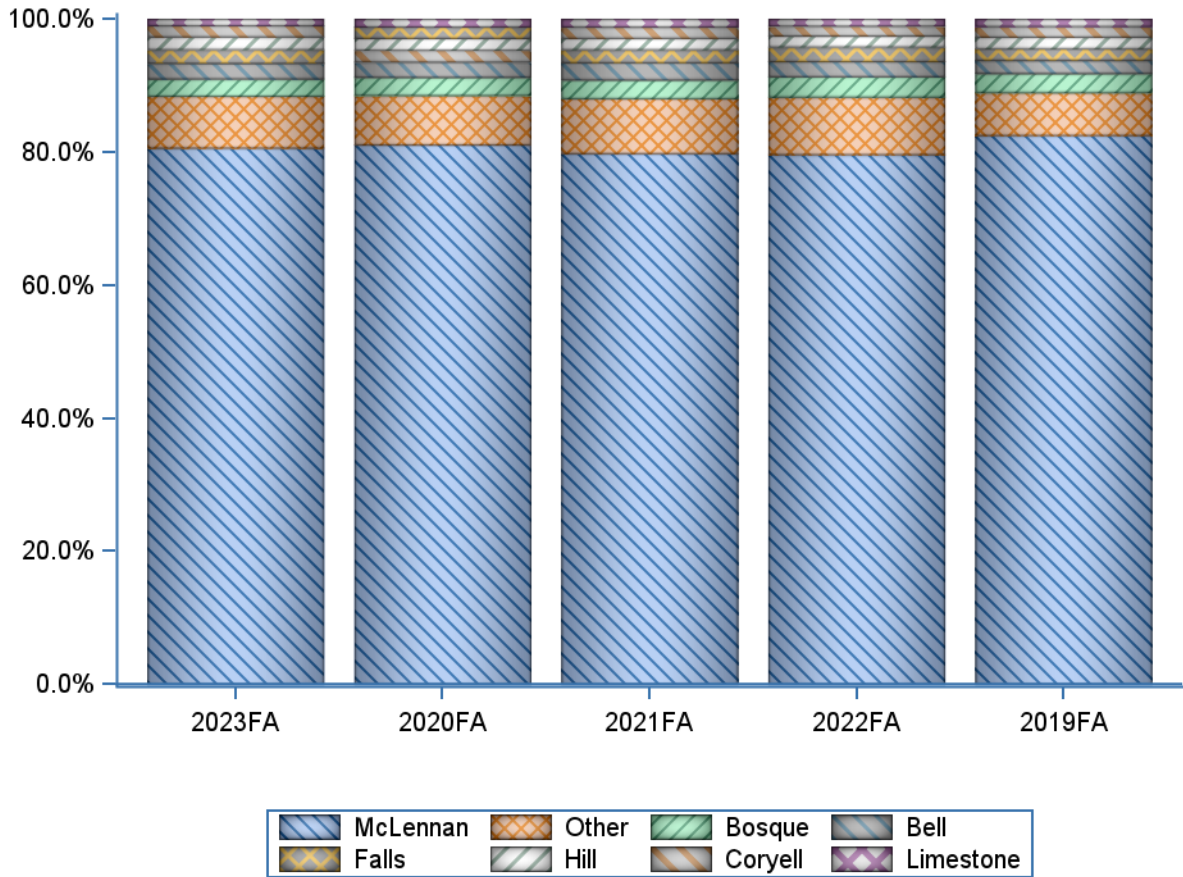

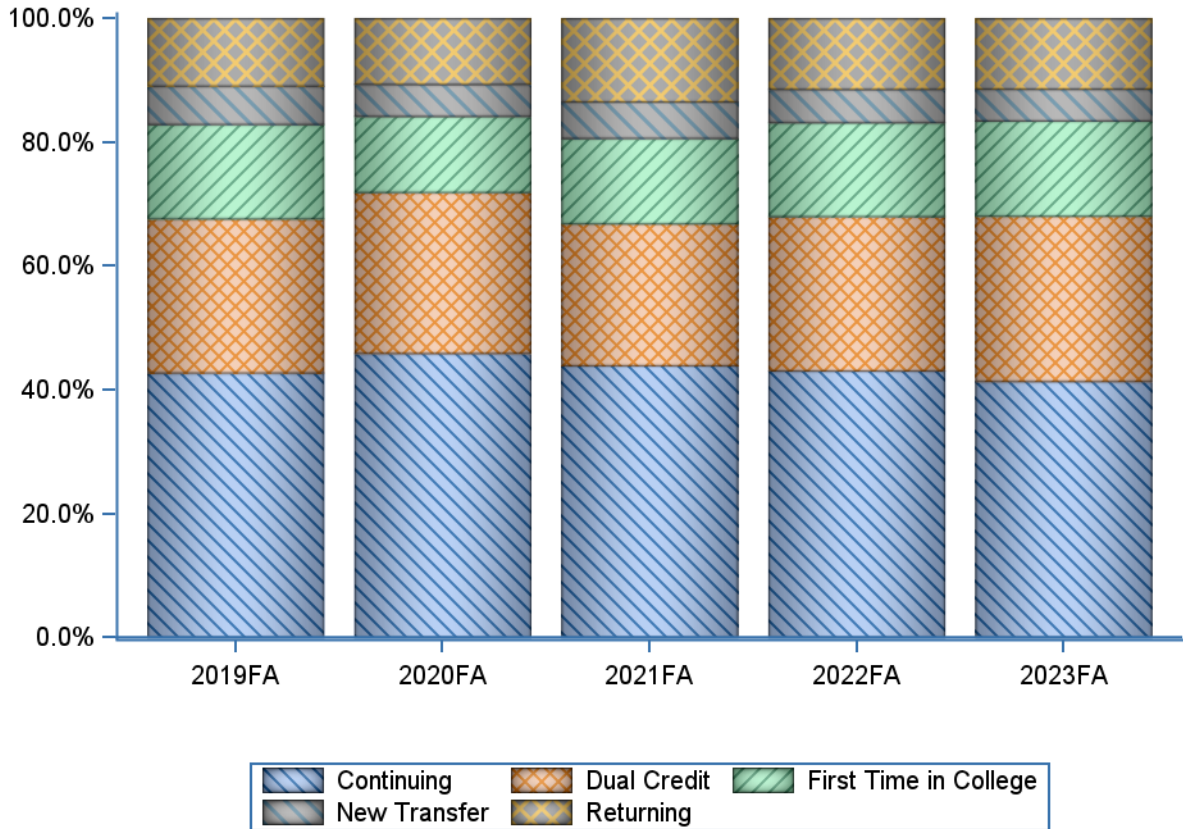
Percent of Enrollment

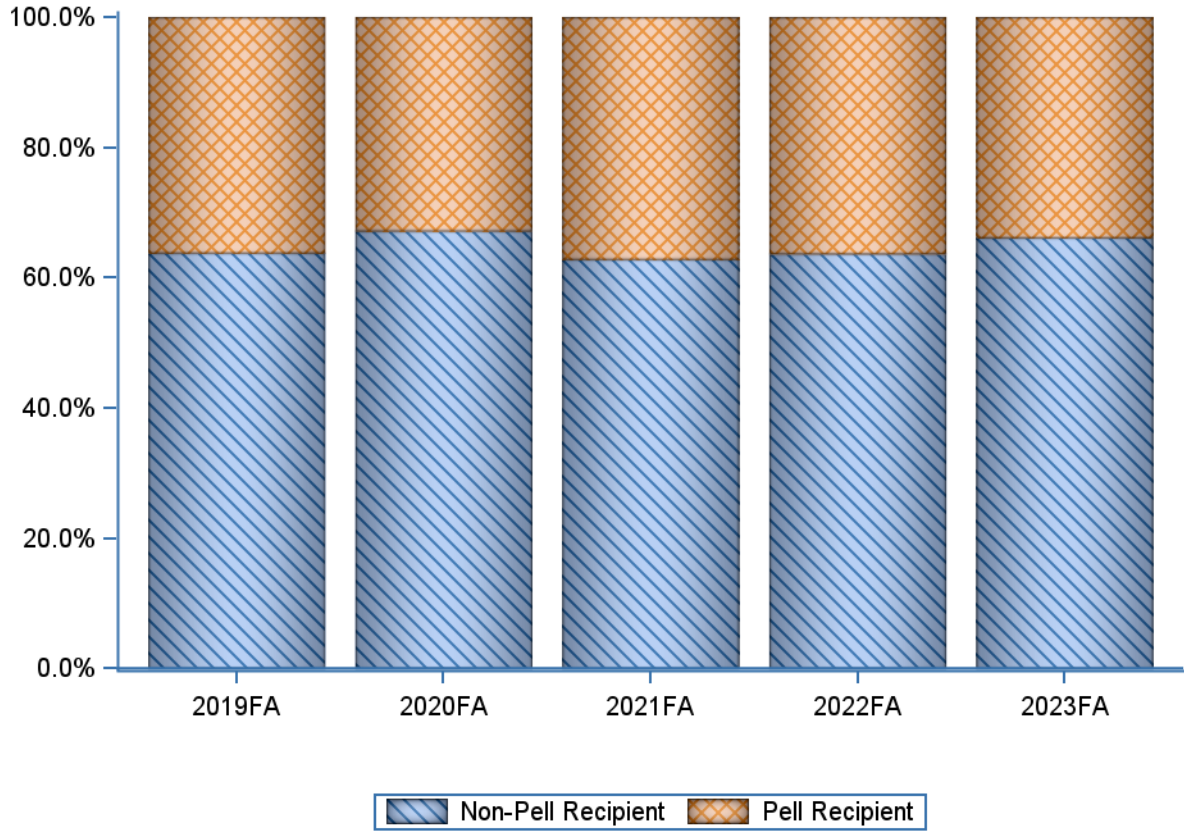
Percent of Enrollment

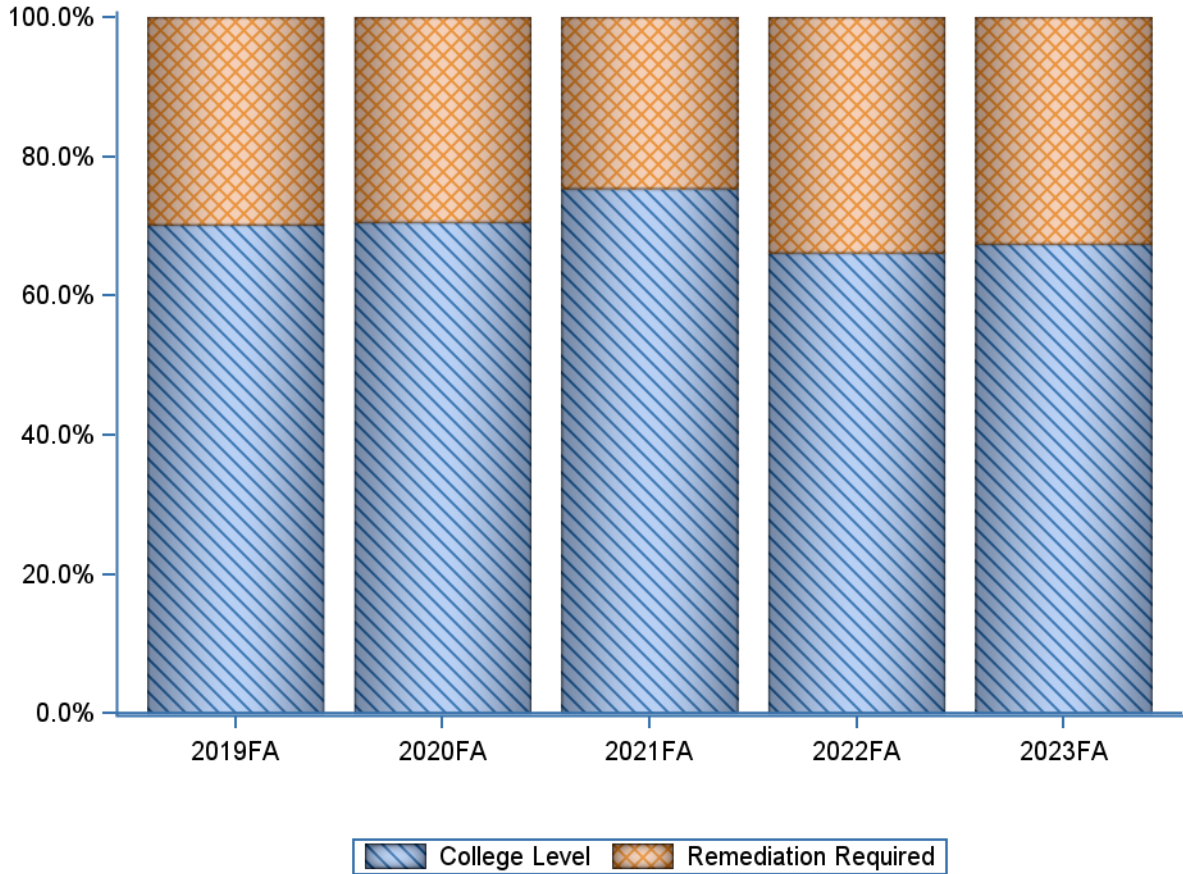
Percent of Enrollment



Profile of all First Time in College Students, Fall 2019 to Fall 2023 Developmental Math Need

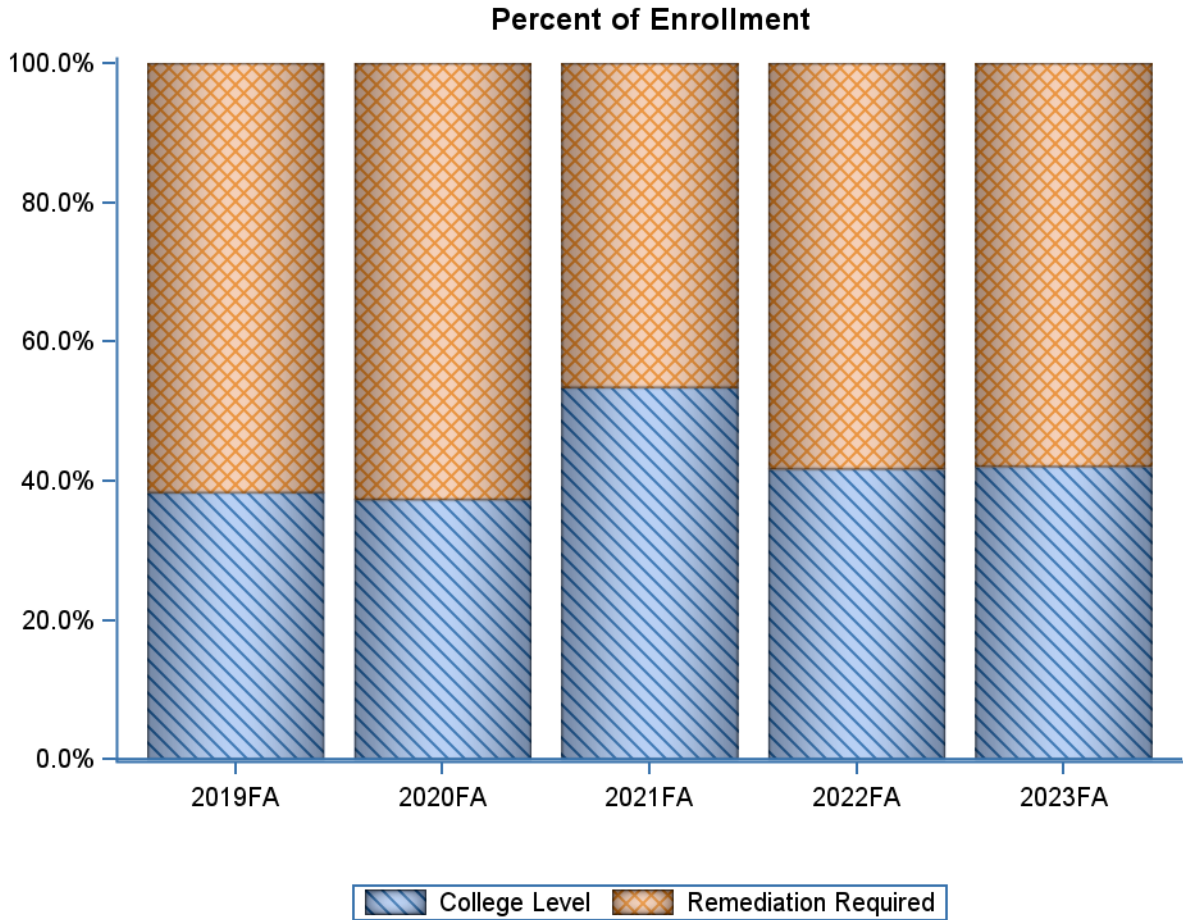

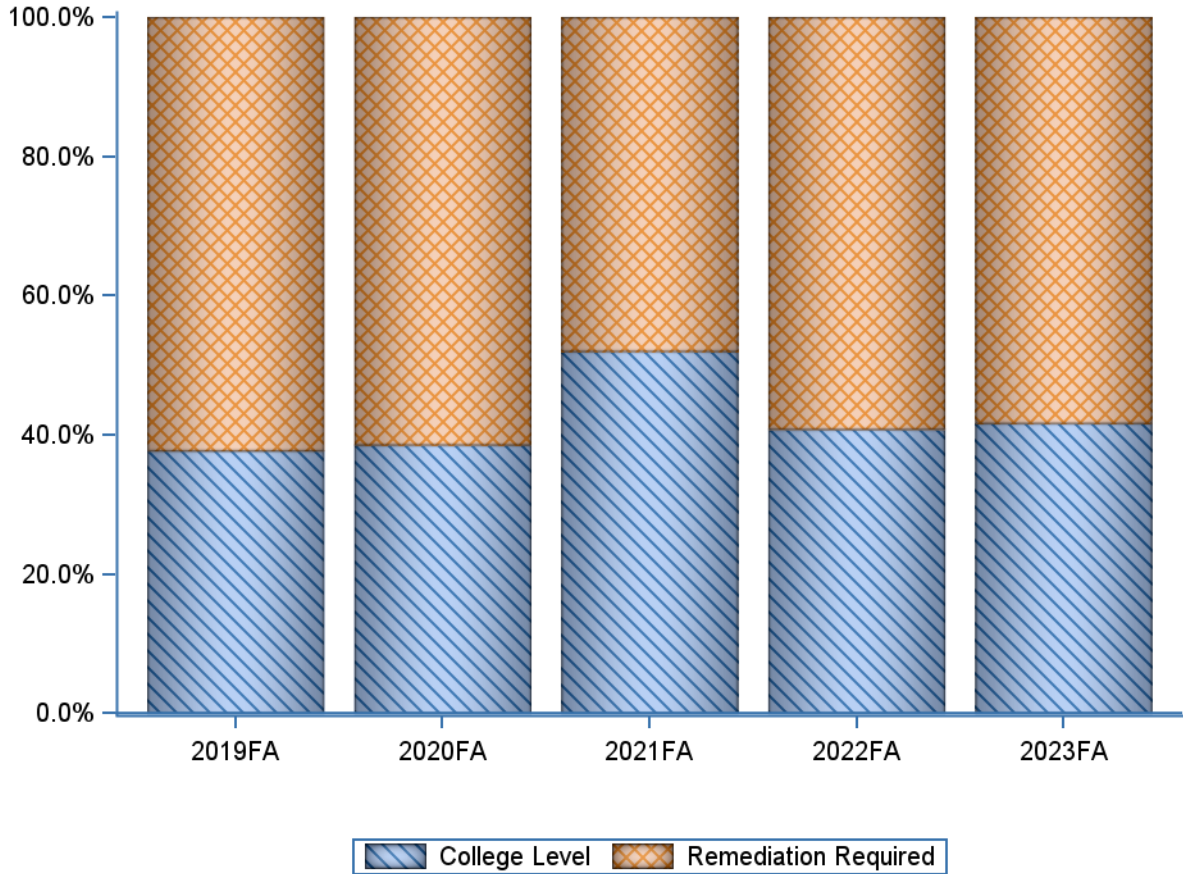

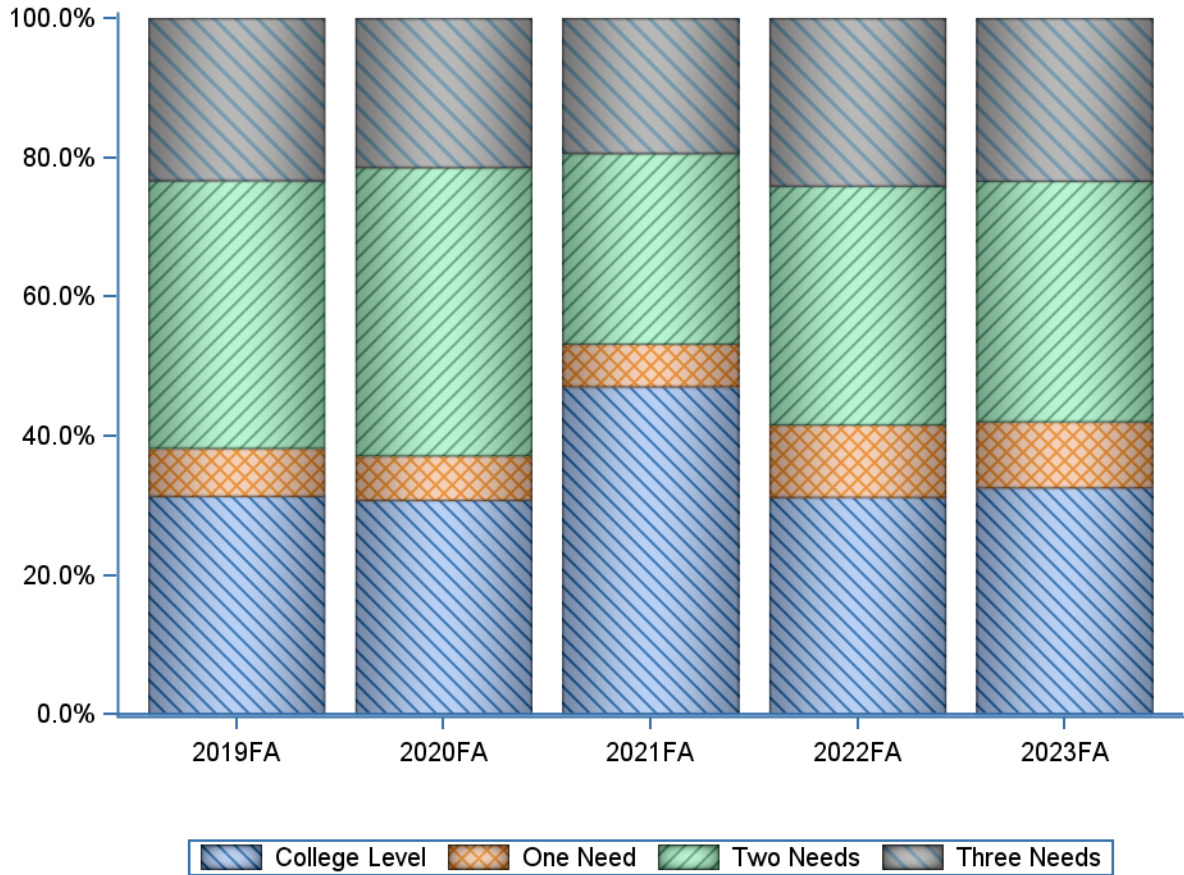
Percent of Enrollment



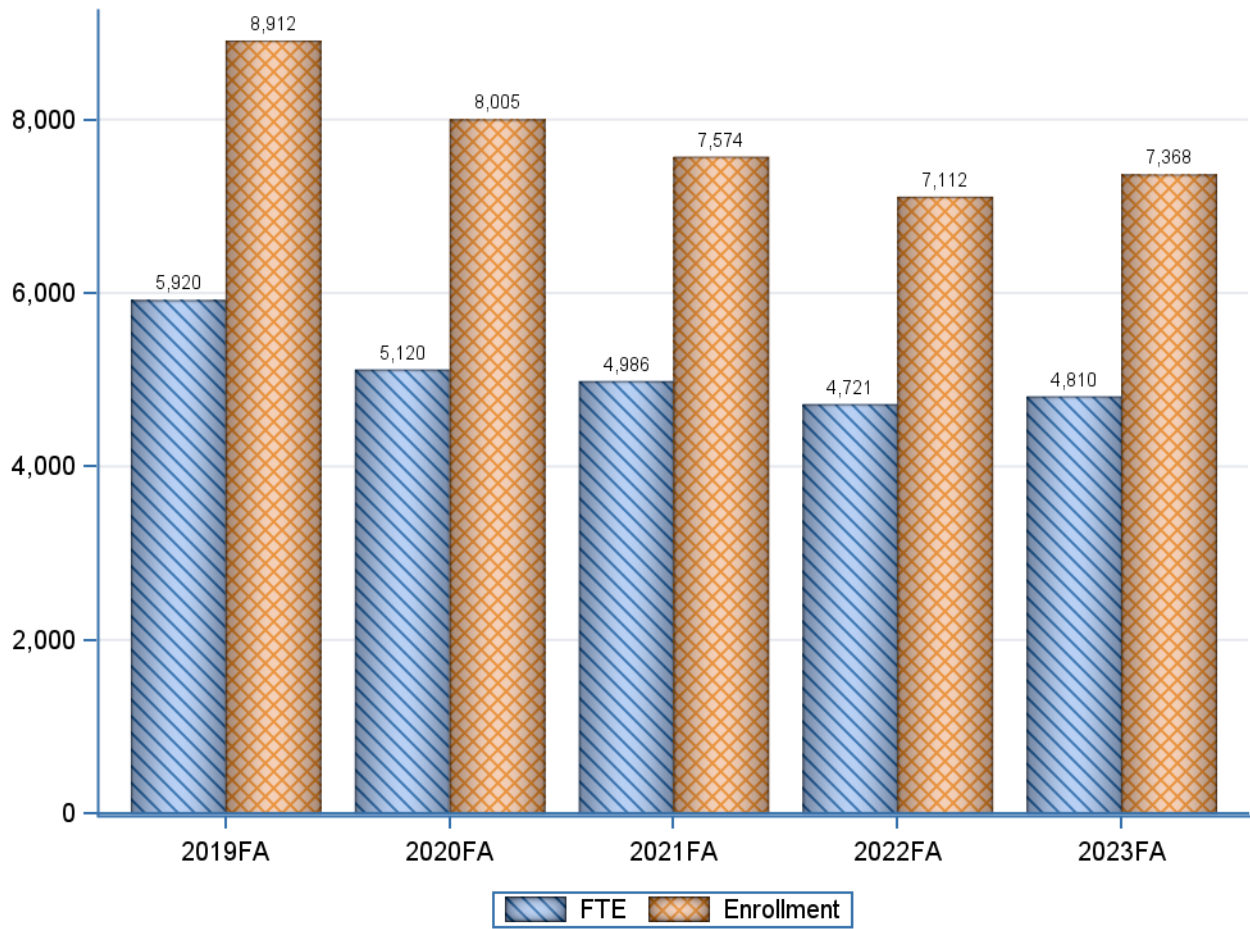

Percent of Enrollment



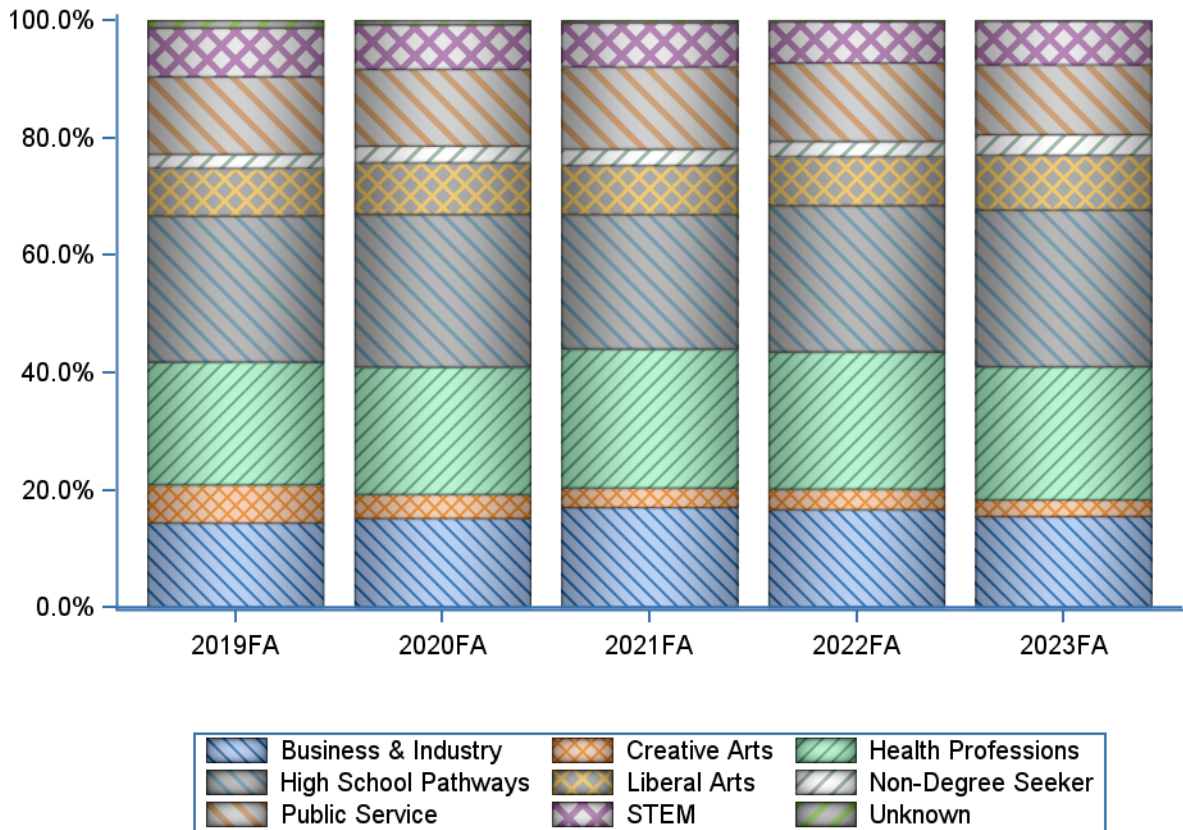
Profile of all Students, Fall 2019 to Fall 2023
