Education Code Sec. 54.365

Senior Citizens; Optional Benefit

- (a) In this section, "senior citizen" means a person 65 years of age or older.
- (b) The governing board of a state-supported institution of higher education may allow a senior citizen to audit any course offered by the institution without the payment of a fee if space is available.
- (c) The governing board of an institution of higher education may allow a senior citizen to enroll for credit in up to six hours of courses offered by the institution each semester or summer term without payment of tuition if space is available.

Credit Data

- 22 students 65+ in credit courses (2022 – 2023)
 - 16 degree seeking / 6 non-degree seeking
 - 160 total credit hours
 - \$68,788 paid in tuition
 - 12 students received financial aid (\$34,895)
 - 6 loans
 - 3 staff/dependent scholarships
 - 4 Pell grants
 - 1 TPEG
 - 1 Foundation scholarship
 - 2 Hazlewood Act (veterans benefit) exemption



Credit Data

- 22 students 65+ in credit courses (2022-2023)
 - Grade Distribution
 - A – 69 (50%)
 - B – 7 (5.07%)
 - C – 9 (6.52%)
 - CR – 4 (2.90%)
 - D – 6 (4.35%)
 - F – 13 (9.42%)
 - W – 30 (21.74%)
- Since Fall 2020 – 10 students have completed a credential
 - Core Completion – 2, Occupational Skills Award – 1, Certificate – 4, Associates - 9



Non-Credit Data

- 678 students 65+ in Continuing Education Courses (2022-2023)
 - Community Programs – 425
 - Corporate Training – 57
 - Ed2Go – 5
 - Health & Human Services – 24
 - Highlander Ranch – 45
 - Law Enforcement Academy – 9
 - Public Computer Class – 17
- \$36,562 paid in tuition
- During 2022-2023 there were no students 65+ that completed a non-credit program
