

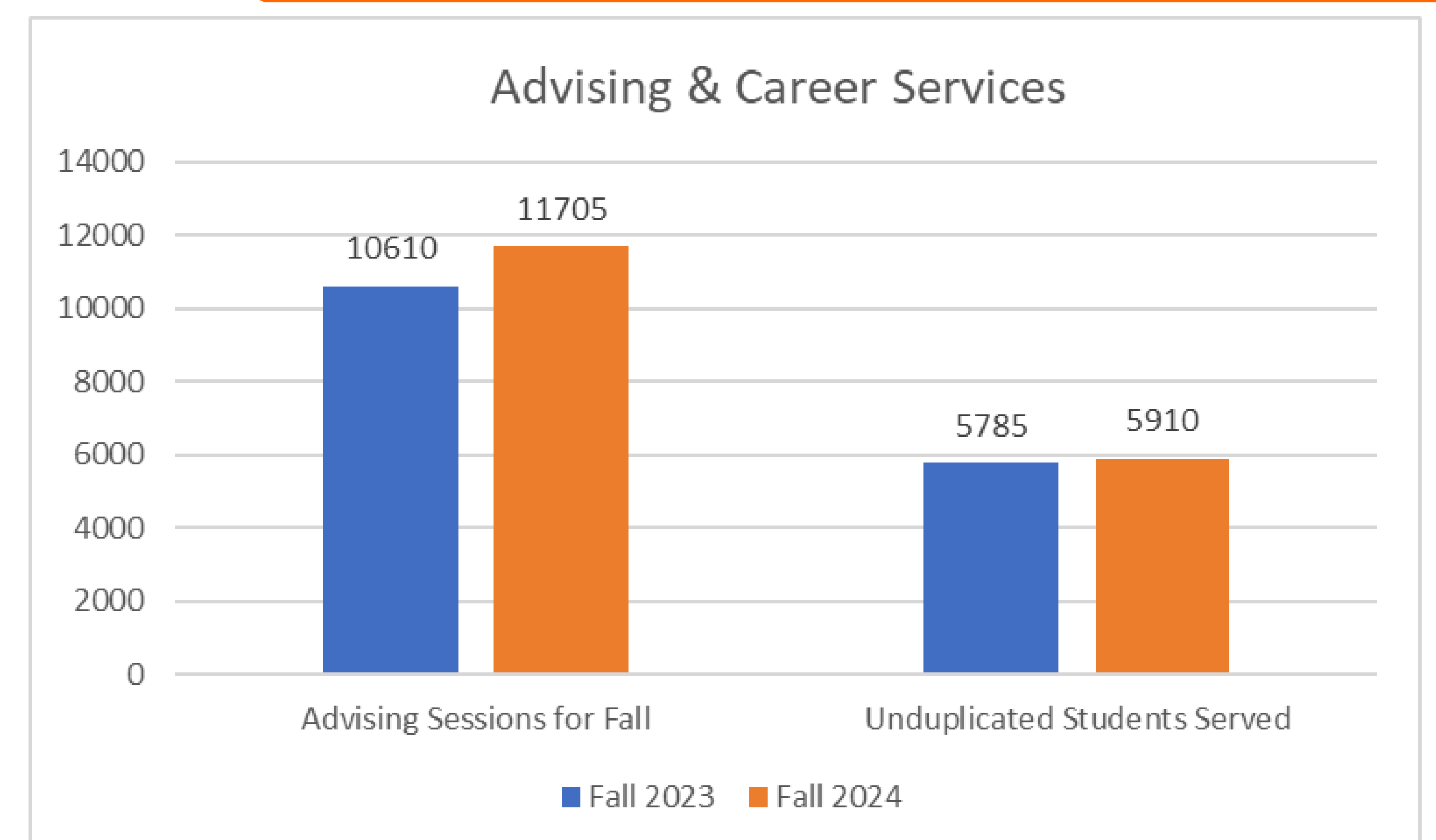


# MCC STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

Student Engagement at MCC fosters student success through a range of proactive and responsive services, events, and outreach. In **Fall 2024**, every department saw a significant rise in both student needs and the number of students served.

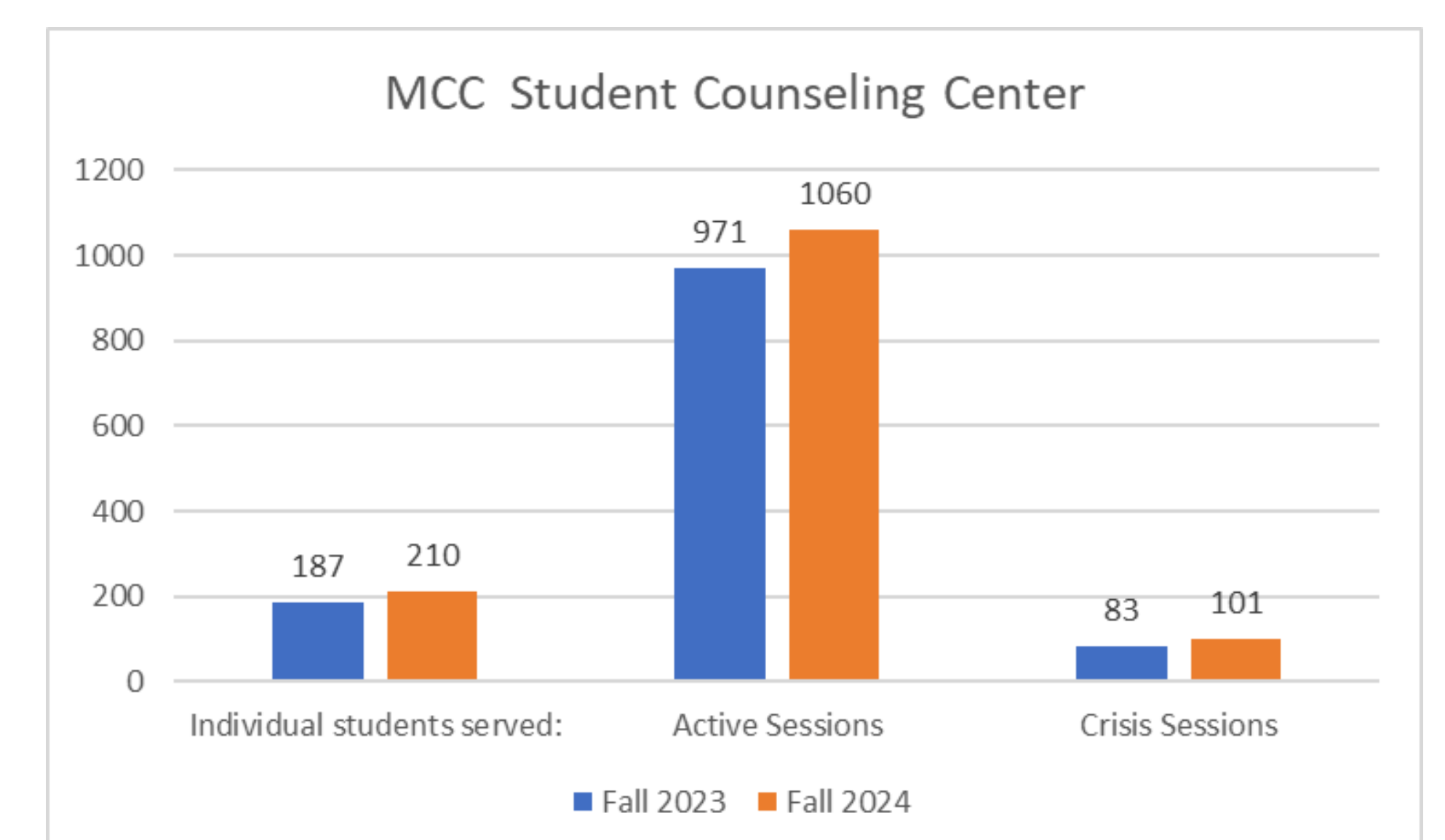
## ADVISING & CAREER SERVICES

Advising and Career Services provides comprehensive academic advising for all First-Time-in-College (FTIC) students, continuing students planning to transfer for a bachelor's degree, and those pursuing pre-Health Professions and pre-Engineering pathways. The team experienced a significant increase in advising sessions leading up to the Fall semester, reflecting both growing student engagement and the department's commitment to proactive academic support.



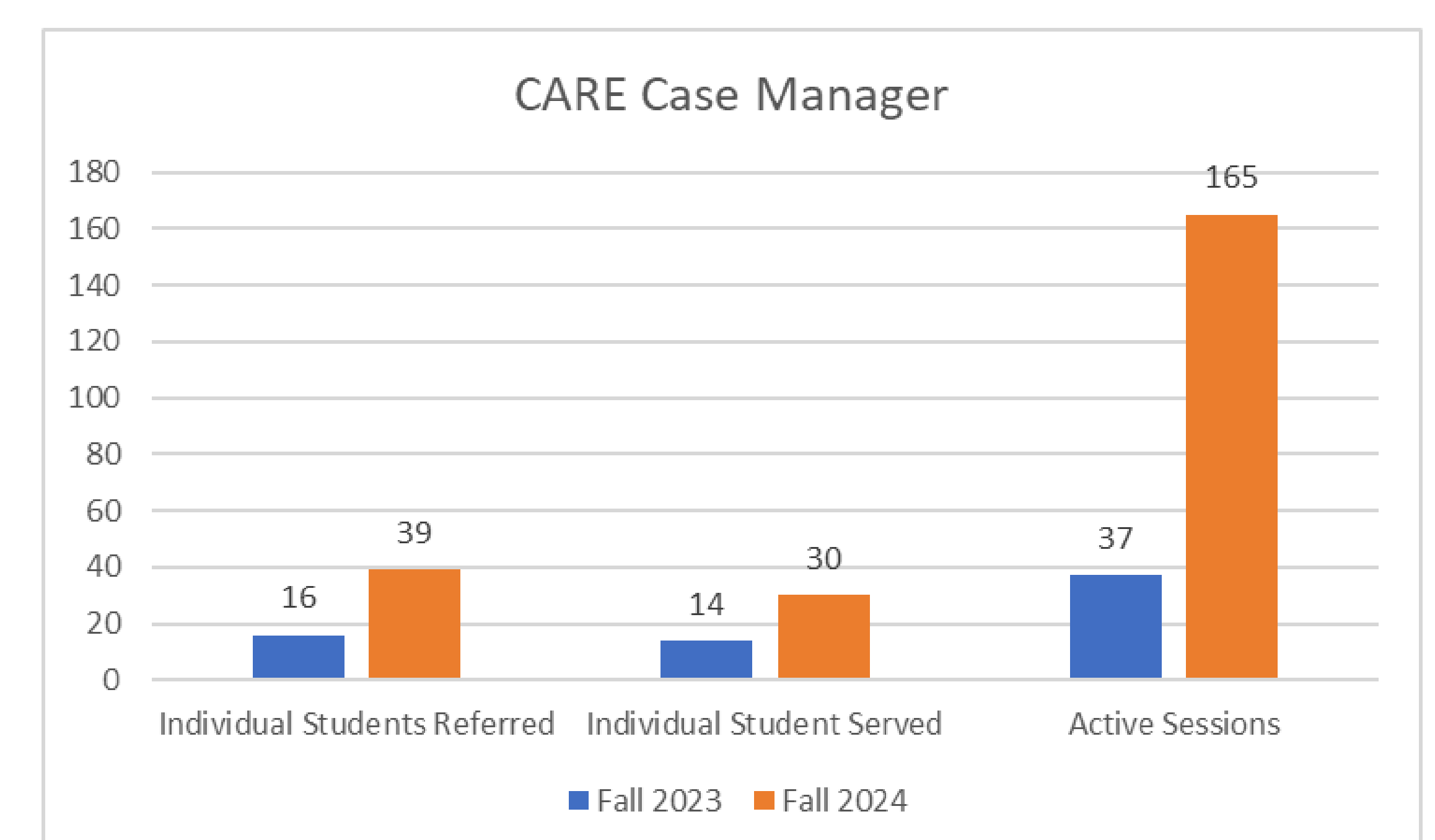
## COUNSELING

During Fall 2024, the MCC Student Counseling Center experienced a 10% increase in active sessions, a 22% rise in crisis sessions, and an 8% growth in students served compared to Fall 2023. These trends align with national patterns, and we anticipate continued increases in student crises. The center is grateful for the new counseling offices, which help accommodate these growing needs.



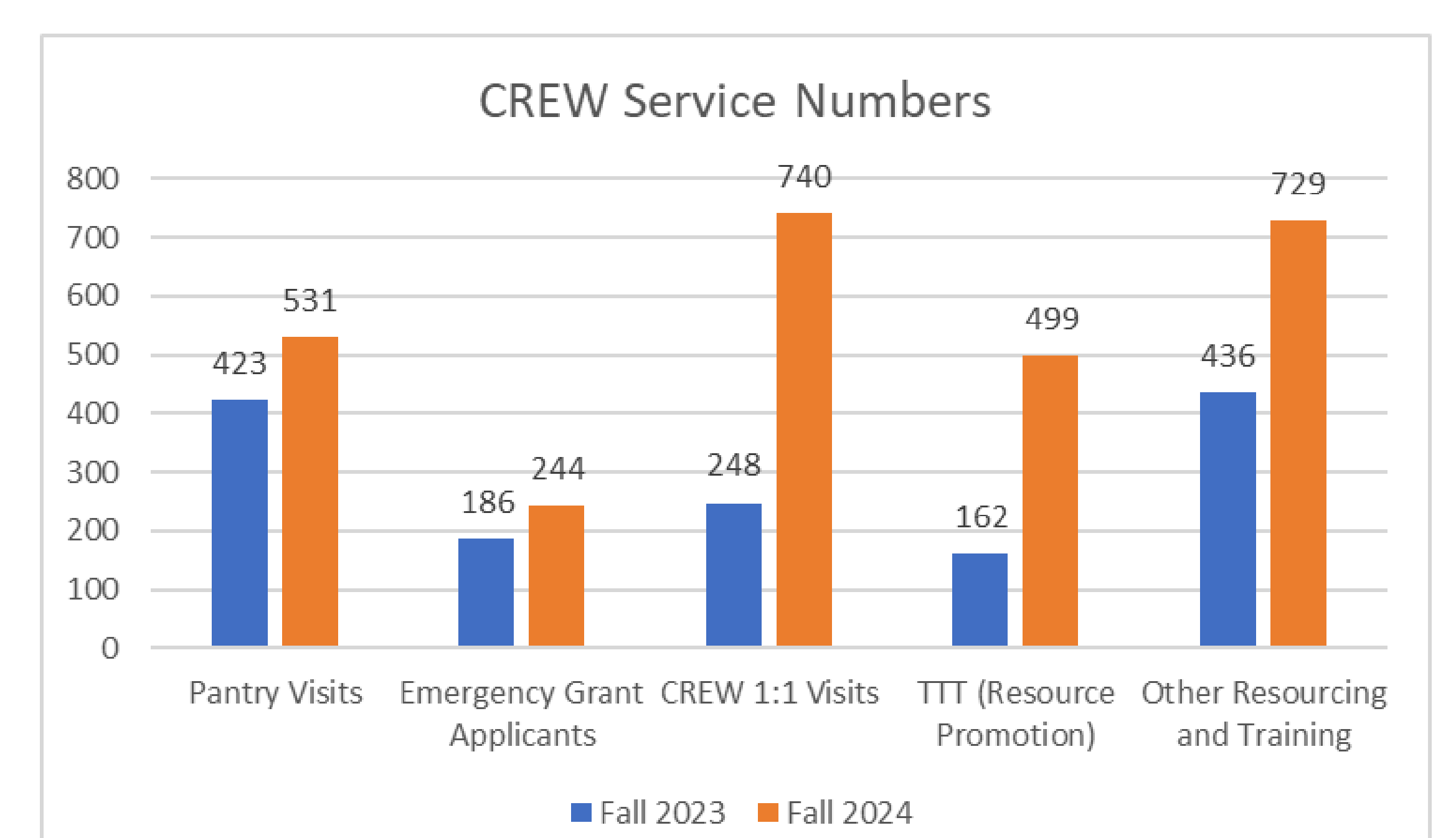
## CARE

C.A.R.E (Campus Assessment, Response & Evaluation), provides coordinated support for students experiencing distress or posing a potential threat to themselves or others, ensuring both their success and campus safety with dignity and respect. In Fall 2024, referrals increased by 143%, doubling the number of students served, while active CARE sessions rose by 345%.



## CREW

McLennan Community College's (MCC) Campus Resources Education Web (CREW) is committed to removing barriers to education by addressing students' basic needs insecurities. In alignment with national trends, MCC experienced a nearly 200% increase in students seeking assistance, leading to a 26% rise in visits to Paulanne's Food Pantry and a 31% increase in Emergency Grant applications.

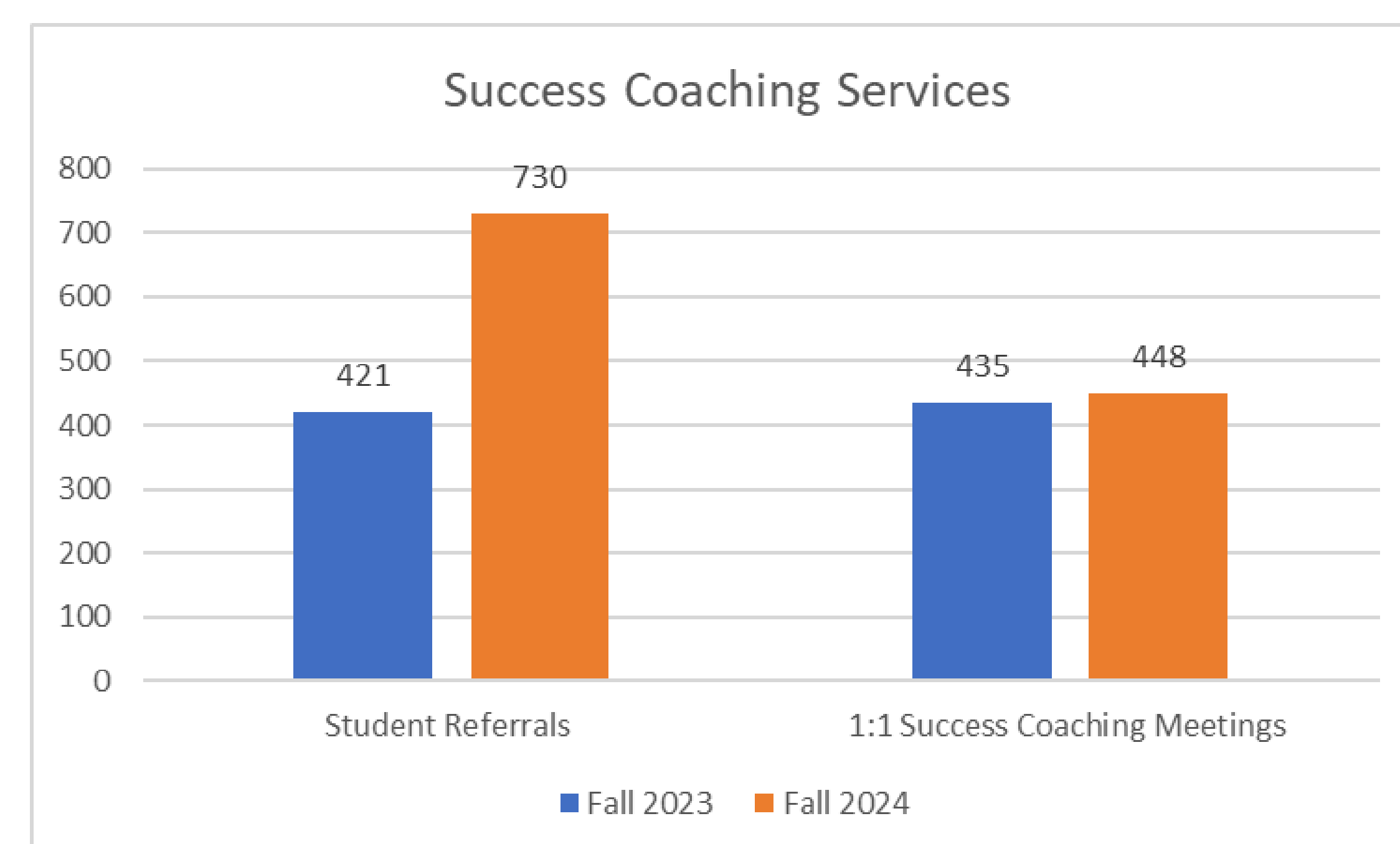




# MCC STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

## SUCCESS COACHING SERVICES

Success Coaching Services (SCS) empowers students with the support, resources, and accountability needed for success. Through one-on-one coaching, students build on their strengths, explore new strategies, and develop personalized plans to achieve their goals. In Fall 2024, SCS experienced a 73% increase in student referrals and successfully served more students, despite operating with two fewer staff members.

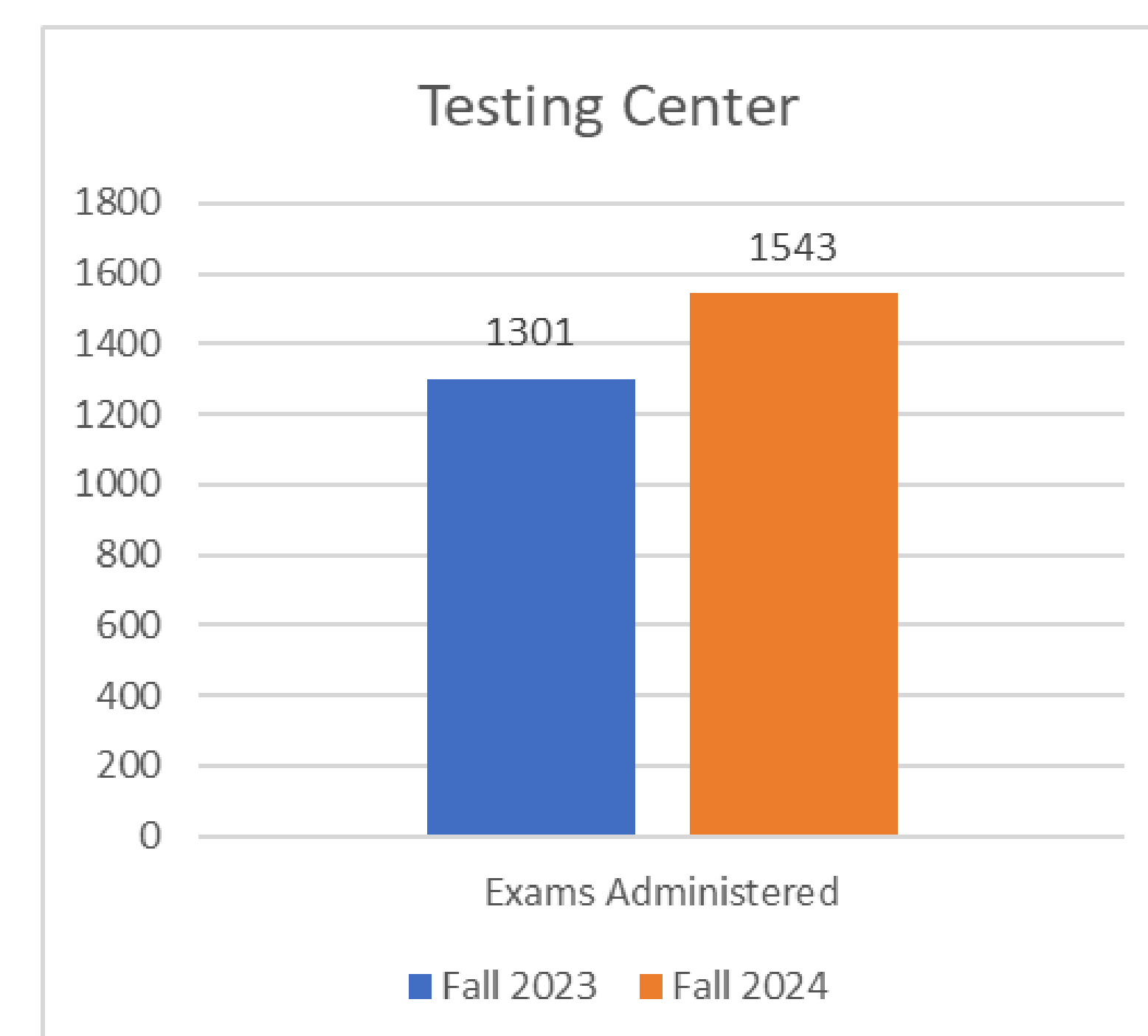


## TRIO STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

The Federally funded SSS program at MCC is designed to help low-income and first-generation Americans enter college, graduate, and continue to participate more in America's economic and social life. During the Fall 2024 semester the SSS team supported all 240 students that they funded to serve.

## TESTING SERVICES

The Testing Services Department provides MCC students and the broader community with a seamless and supportive testing experience, including accommodations testing, placement exams, and certification exams. In Fall 2024, Testing Services administered 19% more exams than the previous year. To further support student success, the department is exploring ways to expand the availability of College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) exams.



## STUDENT LIFE

The Student Life Center (SLC) continues to grow as a hub for student connection, relaxation, and engagement through a variety of activities and games. In Fall 2024, the SLC saw a 108% increase in individual students served and a 30% rise in visits. Beyond the center, the Student Life Team fosters a dynamic campus experience by organizing events and supporting student clubs and organizations.
