Iconic Character Project

For this project we had to pick an iconic character and break down the elements of that costume, then translate those elements into Historical, Modern, and Dance Designs. I decided to go with Beast from *Beauty and the Beast*.





Beast

Beast's original outfit is made up of these items:

- Blue/gold jacket
- White shirt
- Gold vest
- White cravat
- Black Pants

I will also be including the iconic rose from the movie in my design choices.



Historical Beast

For my historical Beast I chose:

- A pair of traditional Roccoco style black shoes w/ buckle
- Black pants
- Brown vest with shadow floral designs
- Blue & gold coat with white cravat
- Traditional Rococo period men's hairstyle with beard & mustache.
- To accessorize is a gold pocket watch with ornate rose cover.



Modern Beast

For my version on modern Beast I chose:

- A red graphic tee with the word BEAST across the front that has claw marks ripped across it
- A blue & yellow letterman style button up jacket
- A pair of blue jeans
- Black Chuck Taylor hi-top
- To finish off is a semi messy hairstyle, beard w/ mustache and a leather phone case with roses.



Dance Beast (Ballet)

For dance (Ballet) Beast I chose:

- Black mens pointe shoes
- Black dance tights
- An off-white ballet blouse
- Ornate blue & gold ballet jacket
- To finish off the look is a long hairstyle with added man bun and a scruffy beard/mustache.
