<b>Total Degree Hours:</b>	<b>120</b>			
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*A student majoring in sociology must complete 30 hours in sociology or criminology, 24 of which must be upper-division courses (3000 or 4000). It is the student's responsibility to make sure they reach the 40 upper-division hours that are required for graduation. Communication Literacy requirements will be met in the required upper-division core courses specified above through numerical data analyses, written papers, and visual/audio in-person or Web-based presentations. A maximum of 9 hours of transfer credit may be accepted for the major. For a course to apply to the major or minor, a student must score a C or better. Students who wish to declare a major in Sociology must have a 2.0 TTU cumulative GPA. If a student's GPA falls below 2.0, they be placed on probation for one semester, during which time they must raise their GPA to 2.0. If they are not successful, they will be dropped from the major after that semester.*
