RRT to BSRC Qualifications

Transfer of previously obtained training in Respiratory Care is accepted. This applies to students who possess the RRT credential. To document the RRT credential, verification will be checked through the NBRC registry online database once accepted to the program. The department will grant the holder of the RRT credential 41 semester hours towards the 78 required respiratory care semester hours. This professional credential credit will be granted once the student has successfully completed 9 semester hours of MSU Respiratory Care work.

A minimum of 30 hours must be advanced level.

A minimum of 30 hours must be taken from MSU to satisfy the residency requirement.

Students must meet the University Writing Proficiency Requirement.
